Objectives

Keeping up to date with recently published literature in your research field is an essential part of scientific work. This short course aims to provide basic knowledge on how to facilitate literature search and introduce the use of the most common tools to keep the track of relevant new publications. Participants will be introduced to the largest academic publishers and how to navigate through their websites. We will explore Scopus, Web of Science, and Google Scholar for literature search and possibilities for keeping up to date with recently published literature. We will also cover other tools which could be useful to stay tuned to recently published literature in your research field, such as Table of Contents Alerts (TOC) and Citation alerts. Participants can also try out a feed reader and subscribe to RSS feeds.

Target Group

The course is designed for early-stage PhD students but anyone who is interested is welcome to join.

Prerequisites

Participants need to bring a laptop. The browser you use needs to be updated to the latest version.
